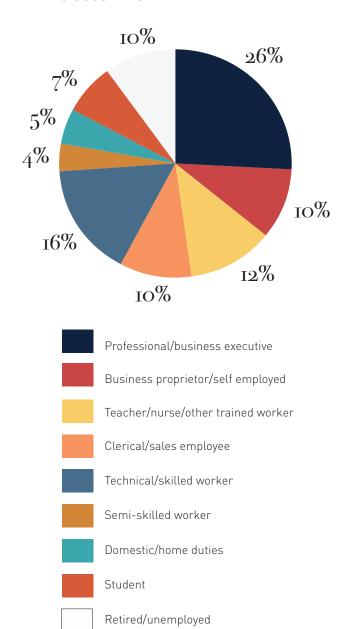

# WHERE OUR READERS GET THEIR PONSONBY NEWS

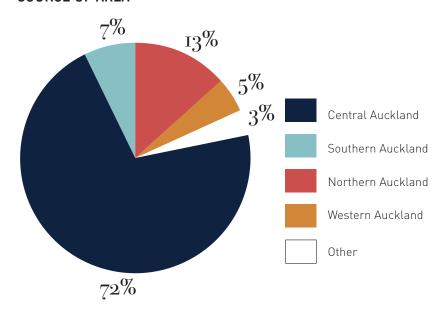

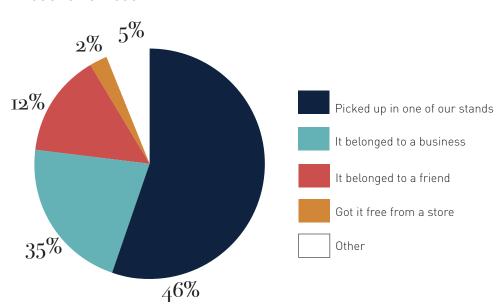

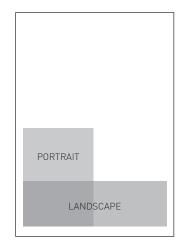

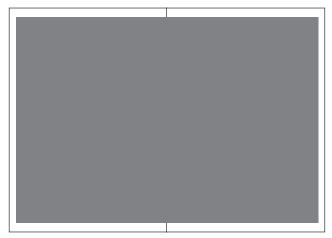

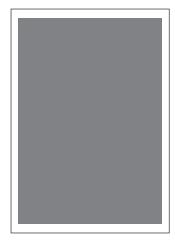

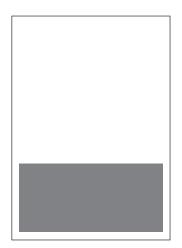

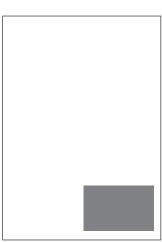

### PONSONBY NEWS DESIGNING YOUR AD

We can make your ad for a small design fee of \$70 + gst per hour. Supply by email all ad material:

- 1. Logo high res 300dpi pdf
- 2. Ad copy in a Word Doc
- 3. Images high res 300dpi jpegs

We brief the designer and an ad proof will be emailed to you for sign off before we go to print.

#### **EDITORIAL**

New advertisers receive a free 250 word editorial with their first insertion. Supply editorial in a Word Doc either as a press release or as draft editorial – we can edit and proof read the draft.

#### FIRST-TIME ADVERTISERS

Pre payment by credit card is required. Credit card details to be phoned into the Ponsonby News office by the 20th of the month or at the time of booking.
